50058 IMS/PIC Submissions for CY 2025 Due Tomorrow

In an email this morning via HUD’s Financial Management Division (FMD) [mailing list](#), HUD’s Office of Public and Indian Housing (PIH) reminded PHAs that they must submit actions recorded on lines 2a and 2b in the forms HUD-50058 no later than 60 calendar days from the effective date, and all actions must be recorded **no later than July 30, 2024**, for consideration for the CY 2025 Operating Funds grants.

PIH uses the HUD-50058 data reported in the Inventory Management System/Public and Indian Housing Information Center ([IMS/PIC](#)) between July 1, 2023, to June 30, 2024 (“the reporting period”) to determine CY 2025 Operating Fund eligibility. PHAs must update IMS/PIC with correct data including field office approval on allowable vacancies **before July 30, 2024**.

HUD to Host Training on PHA 5-Year and PHA Annual Plan Modules

In another email sent this morning via HUD’s Financial Management Division (FMD) [mailing list](#), HUD’s Office of Public and Indian Housing ([PIH](#)) announced that it is hosting an additional training on the PHA 5-Year and PHA Annual Plans modules for PHAs with FYE 12/31 and 3/31. The training will take place tomorrow, Tuesday July 30, 2024, at 1:30 p.m. Eastern time. Click [here](#) to join.

FYE 12/31 PHAs must submit their PHA plans by October 18, 2024, and FYE 3/31 PHAs must submit their required PHA plans by January 17, 2025. HUD Awards \$3.4 Million through FYI Initiative

In a [press release](#) last Friday, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) announced that it has awarded \$3.4 million to 38 PHAs to provide housing assistance to young adults who left foster care or are transitioning out of foster care and are experiencing or at risk of experiencing homelessness. The funding, awarded through HUD’s Foster Youth to Independence ([FYI](#)) initiative, will provide 257 vouchers and administrative fees to these PHAs.
