## **HUD Publishes FY 2021-2022 Rural Capacity Building NOFA**

Yesterday on grants.gov, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) <u>posted</u> the notice of funding availability (<u>NOFA</u>) for the fiscal year (FY) 2021 and 2022 Rural Capacity Building for Community Development and Affordable Housing Grants. The NOFA makes approximately \$10 million available for rural capacity building activities. The application deadline date is **October 11**, **2022**. The funding appropriated for this program is intended to serve high-need rural areas and help rural housing development organizations, community development organizations, community housing development organizations, local governments, and Indian tribes obtain financing, training, and technical assistance necessary to undertake effective community development activities.
