## DBLS Agency/Contractor Guide and Contractor Addendum Now Available

Yesterday on the <u>HUD Exchange News webpage</u>, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) <u>announced</u> that the Davis-Bacon Labor Standards <u>Agency/Contractor</u> <u>Guide</u> and <u>Contractor Guide Addendum</u> are now <u>available</u> on the HUD Exchange. According to the announcement, both guides are new and improved compliance resources that will facilitate agencies' and their contractor partners' understanding of Davis-Bacon and Labor Standards requirements across HUD programs. Both documents are accessible and searchable desktop resources that can be used to answer questions.

> The guide is designed to help agencies develop organizational and administrative policies that will enable them to meet labor standards contractual responsibilities in the administration of HUD-assisted programs as efficiently as possible. It is useful as a training tool and a ready reference for compliance staff. It can also be used by contractors to provide further background.

> The contractor guide addendum was prepared for contractors performing work on construction projects that are assisted by HUD and subject to Davis-Bacon prevailing wage requirements. The objective is to provide contractors with a guide that is simple and non-bureaucratic yet comprehensive that will help contractors better understand and comply with Davis-Bacon labor standards.

Note that the new guides replace the following guidance documents: *Making Davis-Bacon Work:* A Practical Guide for States, Indian Tribes and Local Agencies (2011) and Davis-Bacon Labor Standards: A Contractor's Guide to Prevailing Wage Requirements for Federally-Assisted Construction Projects (2012).
