HUD Posts Resources for VASH Vouchers Registration of Interest

On the HUD–Veterans Affairs (<u>VA</u>) Supportive Housing (<u>HUD-VASH</u>) Vouchers website, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) has posted the following resources related to Notice PIH 2022-26, Registration of Interest for HUD-VASH Vouchers, which was published yesterday:

The notice announces the availability of \$79 million in funding that will support approximately 8,500 new HUD-VASH vouchers and describes the requirements for PHAs interested in requesting FY 2022 HUD-VASH vouchers. These vouchers are administered in partnership with the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs and enable homeless veterans and their families to access affordable housing with an array of supportive services. The deadline for submitting a Registration of Interest is **September 16, 2022.**

HUD Posts Materials for CARES Act Reconciliation and Closeout Webinar

On the <u>HCV Program Trainings and Resources</u> webpage, HUD has posted the <u>recording</u> and <u>presentation slides</u> for the "HCV Program: CARES Act Reconciliation Closeout" webinar that was held on August 11, 2022. The live web conference discussed the recently published Notice <u>PIH-2022-21</u>, which describes the closeout procedures for funds awarded to PHAs under the CARES Act to prevent, prepare for, and respond to the coronavirus. The session covered the closeout timeline, form SF-425 instructions, expectations post submission of SF-425, and questions and answers, among other topics.
