HUD Publishes Document Summarizing RAD Changes

Today in the *Federal Register*, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) published a <u>document</u> summarizing the key changes made to Notice <u>PIH 2019-23/H 2019-09</u> through the RAD Supplemental Notice 4B, <u>PIH 2023-19/H 2023-08</u>, issued on July 27, 2023, and meeting the RAD statutory requirement to publish new waivers and alternative requirements under the program at least 10 days before they become effective. In addition, the document addresses the requirement that RAD may proceed after publication of notice of its terms in the *Federal Register*.

The RAD Supplemental Notice 4B, other than those items listed as new statutory or regulatory waivers or alternative requirements specified in the document, is effective August 21, 2023. The new statutory and regulatory waivers and alternative requirements are effective August 31, 2023. In today's RADBlast!, HUD included a table with the effective date of each section of the supplemental notice.

Additionally, on the <u>RAD Notices webpage</u>, HUD has posted the <u>recording</u>, <u>presentation slides</u>, and question and answers (<u>Q&As</u>) for the webinar on the RAD supplemental notice that took place on Wednesday, August 9, 2023.

HUD Corrects Total Funding for Research Grant NOFO

HUD has also published today in the *Federal Register*, a <u>notice</u> correcting the estimated total funding made available for the Increasing the Supply of Affordable Housing through Off-Site Construction and Pro-Housing Reforms Research Grant Program pre and full application Notice of Funding Opportunity (<u>NOFO</u>), published on June 15, 2023, and closed on August 1, 2023. The correct estimated total funding is approximately \$3 million, and the correct funding source appropriation is the Consolidated Appropriations Act, 2023.
