### HUD to Host Training on SR-FRB Application Submission

In an email yesterday via the Financial Management Division (FMD) [mailing list](#), HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing (PIH) announced that it is hosting a training session on the Small Rural Frozen Rolling Base (SR-FRB) application submission. The training will take place tomorrow, Wednesday August 28, 2024, at 2:00 p.m. Eastern time. Click [here](#) to join.

Under the SR-FRB program, eligible small rural PHAs can freeze their three-year rolling base consumption level that is used to calculate operating subsidy grants. PHAs are eligible to participate in the program if they: 1) Administer 550 or fewer combined public housing units and vouchers under Section 8(o) and 2) Have a primary administrative building with a physical address in a rural area or have more than 50 percent of its combined public housing units and voucher units (housing choice voucher and project-based voucher) under section 8(o) located in rural areas.

The SR-FRB module is now open to submit applications in the [Public Housing Portal](#). The application submission due date is **September 20, 2024**. For further information on the program, please refer to Notice [PIH 2022-32](#) and the SR-FRB [user guide](#).
