Small Rural Frozen Rolling Base Module Now Open

In an [email](#) this morning via the Financial Management Division (FMD) [mailing list](#), HUD’s Office of Public and Indian Housing ([PIH](#)) announced that the Small Rural Frozen Rolling Base ([SR-FRB](#)) module is now open for PHA submission in the public housing portal. The application submission due date is **September 20, 2024**.

PHAs are eligible to participate in the program if they: 1) Administer 550 or fewer combined public housing units and vouchers under Section 8(o) and 2) Have a primary administrative building with a physical address in a rural area or have more than 50 percent of its combined public housing units and voucher units (housing choice voucher and project-based voucher) under section 8(o) located in rural areas.

Training sessions on the SR-FRB module will be provided on [August 8](#) at 10:30 a.m. Eastern time and [August 28](#) at 2:00 p.m. Eastern time. For further information please refer to Notice [PIH 2022-32](#) and the SR-FRB [user guide](#).

It will also include a review of the effective and compliance dates set forth in Notice [PIH 2024-19](#), which was published on June 5, 2024.
