HUD Awards \$87 Million to Address Health Hazards in Public Housing

In a [press release](#) yesterday, the Department of Housing and Urban Development ([HUD](#)) announced that it has awarded more than \$87 million for PHAs to evaluate and reduce residential health hazards in public housing, including lead-based paint, carbon monoxide, mold, radon, and fire safety. The funds will also help PHAs prepare to comply with the National Standards for the Physical Inspection of Real Estate ([NSPIRE](#)).

The awards were provided through the Capital Fund Housing-Related Hazards (HRH) and Lead-Based Paint (LBP) Capital Fund programs. HUD granted 14 awards totaling \$47.7 million under LBP and 22 awards totaling \$40 million under HRH. A state-by-state breakdown of the awardees can be found in the press release.



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
