### PIH Posts Guidance on Energy Performance Contracts and SAC Applications

HUD's Office of Public and Indian Housing (PIH) has posted a guidance for PHAs on Energy Performance Contracts (EPC) and SAC applications. The document, dated September 2022, provides information about requirements related to EPC debt when PHAs propose to remove units from the public housing inventory through SAC applications (i.e., demolition, disposition, voluntary conversion).

# **HUD Awards \$180 Million in Choice Neighborhoods Implementation Grants**

In a <u>press release</u> yesterday, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) announced that it will award \$180 million to four cities to redevelop severely distressed public or HUD-assisted housing under the <u>Choice Neighborhoods</u> initiative. The implementation grants are being awarded to city and housing authority partnerships in Omaha, Nebraska; Durham, North Carolina; Knoxville, Tennessee; and Tulsa, Oklahoma. The four awardees will create 2,323 new mixed-income units as part of an overall effort to revitalize neighborhoods.
