## **HUD Publishes 2022 SHOP NOFA**

Yesterday on <u>Grants.gov</u>, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) <u>published</u> the fiscal year 2022 notice of funding availability (<u>NOFA</u>) for the Self-Help Homeownership Opportunity Program (<u>SHOP</u>). The NOFA makes available \$12,500,000 "to facilitate and encourage innovative homeownership opportunities on a national, geographically diverse basis through the provision of self-help homeownership housing programs." Only national and regional nonprofit organizations and consortia with experience providing self-help homeownership housing programs are eligible to apply. Applicants must propose to use a significant amount of SHOP grant funds in at least two states.
