### PD&R Issues Notice on Unsolicited Research Proposals

Yesterday on grants.gov, HUD's Office of Policy Development and Research (PD&R) announced that it has the authority to accept unsolicited research proposals that address current research priorities. The research proposals must be submitted by eligible applicants and provide cost sharing for at least 50 percent of total project cost from philanthropic entities or federal, state, or local government agencies.
