## HUD Posts Document on Voluntary Reallocation/Recapture of HUD-VASH Vouchers

On the HUD–Veterans Affairs (VA) Supportive Housing (<u>HUD-VASH</u>) Vouchers website, the Department of Housing and Urban Development (<u>HUD</u>) has posted a <u>presentation</u> covering the HUD-VASH Voluntary Reallocation or Recapture <u>notice</u> that was published on August 16, 2022. The document covers the following topics:

- Overview and background of the notice
- Reallocation vs. recapture
- When to consider reallocation or recapture
- Overview of the request and approval process
- PHA request letter requirements
- Processing timeline
- Next steps and questions

As the document states, Notice <u>PIH 2022-25</u> is intended to increase efficiency and impact of existing HUD-VASH resources by moving vouchers from areas with chronically low utilization to areas with additional need.

# HUD Posts Materials for EHV Landlord Engagement Webinars

On the <u>HUD Exchange News webpage</u>, HUD <u>announced</u> that it has posted the materials for two sessions in its "EHV Landlord Engagement" webinar series.

- <u>Marketing, Outreach, and Retention</u>: During this live web conference, held on July 12, 2022, HUD provided guidance on understanding landlords, marketing to landlords, campaign strategies, and community examples.
- <u>Supporting Households through the Housing Search</u>: This webinar, held on July 26, 2022, provided guidance on understanding how to assess and respond to housing preferences and barriers, discussing how to prepare the household, and learning ways to find units and leverage existing resources for housing search.


